



Directions to Fall Baseball Fields 2008

Keyes Field (Milford)

From the east travel West on Rt. 101/Amherst St: proceed into Milford and continue around the rotary(second right off rotary) and remain West on Rt. 101. The turn for Keyes Field is located less than ½ mile on our right after you pass the rotary. It is marked with granite pillars and the street leads you to the field which is on the left.

From the West: Take Rt. 101 East towards downtown Milford(stay on Rt. 101: not 101A bypass). The entrance to the field is on your left and shortly after you pass Wendy's. If you get to the rotary you have gone too far.

The field is not visible from the road and the entrance is easy to miss. Look for the granite pillars.

Hollis Brookline High School (24 Cavalier Court) Hollis, NH. 03049)

FROM ROUTE 3 (EVERETT TURNPIKE) NORTHBOUND:

Take Exit 6 (Hollis/Brookline, Silver Lake State Park Exit). Bear left of the exit, heading west on route 130 or Broad Street (passing Nashua Mall and Plaza on the left). Proceed straight on route 130 for about 5 miles into Hollis. After passing Lull Farm and Brookdale Fruit Farm on the left, bear right, staying on route 130 (also called Ash Street). Follow Ash Street for roughly a quarter mile to the only traffic light in Hollis (called the Four Corners) Take a left. The school will be a half-mile on your right set back from the road. The field is located in front of school. There is a large stone sign at the foot of the driveway.

FROM ROUTE 3 (EVERETT TURNPIKE) SOUTHBOUND:

Take exit 6 as above. At the end of the exit ramp, bear right. Proceed straight on route 130 for about 5 miles into Hollis. After passing Lull Farm and Brookdale Fruit Farm on the left, bear right, staying on route 130 (also called Ash Street). Follow Ash Street for roughly a quarter mile to the only traffic light in Hollis (called the Four Corners) Take a left. The school will be a half-mile on your right set back from the road. Field will be in front of school. There is a large stone sign at the foot of the driveway.

Ledge St. School (139 Ledge St. Nashua, NH. 03060) (Baseball)

Exit 5A (Simon St.) off of Rt. 3 Northbound

Come off ramp and go straight through 4 way stop. Ledge Street school will be on your left. Take first left after school and then left into parking lot.

North Common Field -- Nashua

Behind Homan Stadium

Corner of Artillery Lane and Sargents Avenue

From Everett Turnpike (RT 3), take exit 7E onto Amherst Street. Holman Stadium is approximately one mile on the left

Directions to Hollis-Brookline Middle School Field:

From Route 3 (Everett Turnpike) Northbound:

Take Exit 6 (Hollis/Brookline, Silver Lake Park Exit). Bear left off the exit, heading west on Route 130 or Broad Street (passing Nashua Mall and Plaza on the left). Proceed straight on Route 130 for about 5 miles into Hollis. After passing Lull Farm and Brookdale Fruit Farm on the left, bear right, staying on Route 130 (also called Ash Street). Follow Ash Street for roughly a quarter mile to the traffic light (called four corners). Take a left. After approximately a half-mile, take a right onto Love Lane (if you get to the High School driveway you have gone too far). Once on Love Lane, you will see the Middle School and the baseball field on your right. Parking is allowed in the school parking lot. DO NOT park along the road on Love Lane – vehicles will be towed.

From Route 3 (Everett Turnpike) Southbound:

Take Exit 6 (Hollis/Brookline, Silver Lake Park Exit). Bear right at the end of the exit ramp. Proceed straight on Route 130 for about 5 miles into Hollis. After passing Lull Farm and Brookdale Fruit Farm on the left, bear right, staying on Route 130 (also called Ash Street). Follow Ash Street for roughly a quarter mile to the traffic light (called four corners). Take a left. After approximately a half-mile, take a right onto Love Lane (if you get to the High School driveway you have gone too far). Once on Love Lane, you will see the Middle School and the baseball field on your right. Parking is allowed in the school parking lot. DO NOT park along the road on Love Lane – vehicles will be towed.

From Route 101 West/East:

Take the exit for Amherst, Milford, Route 101A. Bear right off the exit onto route 101A heading toward Nashua. At the intersection of routes 101A and 122, take a right onto 122. Follow Route 122 into Hollis, past Silver Lake State Park and the Hollis Primary School (both on your right). Proceed straight through the traffic light at the four corners. After approximately a half-mile, take a right onto Love Lane (if you get to the High School driveway you have gone too far). Once on Love Lane, you will see the Middle School and the baseball field on your right. Parking is allowed in the school parking lot. DO NOT park along the road on Love Lane – vehicles will be towed.
